- 1. Call to Order- Jack Locke, Chairman
- 2. Establishment of Quorum: Jack Locke, Roy Brooks, Tommy Leuenberger, Frank Acuff & Ross Statham of the Executive Committee were in attendance as well as Calvin Palmer of AVCON and Mark Wilson, Airport Manager, as per the sign-in sheet.
- 3. Invocation by Ross Statham.
- 4. Regarding Tri-County Airport Authority grant received from FDOT, Brooks moved and Leuenberger seconded that we direct the Chairman to sign Resolution 24-02 which grants permission for Chairman Locke to sign the grant for Future Hangar Site Improvements. Motion carried unanimously.
